**Part 1: Sin**

Sin is less of an act committed . (it is that.)

Sin is more of an attitude of rebellion against God .

Romans 3:23 - *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*

Romans 6:23 - *For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

**Part 2: God's Grace**

Grace is unmerited favor , or a free gift .

**Part 3: Confession and Repentance .**

Confess: telling one's life story as a series of failings or tribulations .

Repent: to feel sorrowful or mournful over something either done or left - undone .
