Week 4: Missional Living

FAMILY SEND OFF

• Gather the family sometime before everyone is about to leave the house. Join hands and say a quick prayer together. The prayer can be short - just spend time praying for God to use you and commit to going into the world as Jesus did together as a family. (ex. "Bless us as we work, study, and play. May we bring glory and honor to you today. Amen.")

CHALK MESSAGES

Draw pictures, write verses and write sayings like "Jesus loves you" on the sidewalks in your neighborhood.

NURSING HOME VISIT

• Pick a bouquet of flowers and make cards with verses and prayers to give out to people in the nursing home you choose. Take some time to pray for and with the residents there.

COOKIE PACKAGE

• Bake some family favorite cookies. Decorate a box with pictures, drawings, and verses and line it with aluminum foil. Put the baked cookies inside of the box and include a scripture note. Take the completed box to a local police station, fire station, post office, or other community based location.

DRIVE THRU NOTES

• Make decorative cards and write a verse inside of each one. Put them in the car and each time your family goes through a drive thru, hand out a card or two to the people at that drive thru window.

CHURCH INVITE BAGS

• Decorate paper lunch bags and fill them with candy, stickers, snacks, or other inexpensive items. Include information about your church inside, inviting them to come with you to a service or church event. As a family, hand them out around your neighborhood or shopping area close by.

PRAYER WALL/CHAIN

• Designate a spot in your home to list family, friends, coworkers, classmates, or neighbors in your life that do not believe in Jesus. This may be a dry erase board, a paper chain, a window (that you write on with dry erase markers!) or another area. List out these people, and pray for each of them by name - that they come to know Jesus as their Savior and that God uses each of you to share the Good News with them boldly. Hang it up in your home as a reminder to continue praying for those people and praying for opportunities to share Jesus with them.

MEAL TALK

• Invite a friend or neighbor and their family over for a meal this weekend who doesn't know Jesus. Use this opportunity to start building a relationship with them.

WORDLESS BRACELET/BOOK
