

Series: The Good Work – A Study of Philippians

Series Overview: This is a 5-week study that will walk through some foundations of the Christian faith – salvation, justification, sanctification, identity, and glorification.

Goals:

1. Students will understand that salvation begins with God, not their effort.
 - Students will identify one area where they try to “earn” God’s approval and surrender that belief during reflection or prayer.
 - Students will articulate in their own words what it means that “He who began a good work in you will carry it to completion.”
2. Students will trust in the finished work of Jesus as the foundation of their faith.
 - Students will articulate what justification means and what it means to be made righteous.
 - Students will share one way the finished work of Jesus changes how they see their failures or insecurities.
3. Students will recognize how God continues to transform them daily through the Holy Spirit
 - Students will name one false identity they’ve been carrying and replace it with a truth from Philippians.
 - Students will describe how being “found in Christ” shapes their identity and daily decisions.
 - Students will identify one area where God is currently growing them and commit to a practical obedience step this week.
