

Series: Your Hallways Matter

Series Overview: Your school isn't just a place you go and spend your time – it's a place God has intentionally sent you. Every hallway, classroom, cafeteria table, bus ride, practice, rehearsal, and friend group is part of your daily mission field. This series will help students see their everyday environments as opportunities to live out and speak out the gospel with courage, compassion, and clarity.

Goals:

1. Students will recognize their daily environments as God-given mission fields.
 - Students will identify at least one space in their school (a hallway, class, team, lunch table) where they want to intentionally live out or show the love of Jesus.
 - Students will commit to one practical way they can represent Christ in that space this week.
2. Students will grow in Christlike character as they “put on” the new self.
 - Students will reflect on their “old self” and confess them to God.
 - Students will choose a Christlike trait to intentionally practice in their hallways.
3. Students will develop courage and clarity in speaking about their faith.
 - Students will identify one person they can pray for, encourage, or speak to about Christ in the coming week.
 - Students will practice relying on the Holy Spirit by preparing a simple, authentic way to talk about their faith or invite someone to church.
