

Series: Reset

Series Overview: Kicking off the new year by “re-aligning” our lives: identity, priority, and direction. The next three weeks will invite students to slow down, seek the kingdom, and allow Jesus to reorder the core areas in their lives. In a study of Matthew 6, we will explore identity, priority, and God-shaped direction.

Series Memory Verse: “But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.” Matthew 6:33

Goals: In the next 3 weeks, the goal for our students is to leave with a kingdom-centered mindset. And a new Lense on:

- Students will realign their identity by remembering who they are in Christ
 - Students will identify one area where they have been defining themselves by achievement, approval, appearance, or comparison and surrender it to God through prayer and/or journaling.
 - Students will articulate one truth about God’s character and how that reshapes the way they see themselves.
- Students will re-center their priorities around seeking the Kingdom first
 - Students will evaluate the top 3 things currently getting most of their time, attention or emotional energy and figure out how they are misaligned with Jesus’ teaching
 - Students will commit to one small shift to put Jesus at the center (Scripture before phone, worship over worry, etc.)
- Students will learn to trust God’s provision and let go of worry-driven living
 - Students will name one area where they feel anxious or pressured and bring it to God in prayer and bring it to community for group prayer.
 - Students will memorize Matthew 6:33 and use it as encouragement when worried and as a filter when making decisions.
