Key Notes

Individual Will (<i>Misconception</i>)	Moral Will of God
Detailed plan for decisions	Body of general commands
We're expected to find and do it	We're expected to find and do it
Revealed to our hearts, but not really found in the Bible	Revealed to apostles/prophets and is all in the Bible
Revealed by the Holy Spirit through inward impressions	Revealed by the Holy Spirit through supernatural revelation in God's Word
Specific directions for one person	General directions for all people

How we make decisions:

1. God is sovereign and in control, which comforts us
2. God's Word and the Holy Spirit reveal truth to us
3. Within these things, we have the freedom to choose
 - With the help of godly counsel and clear road signs

**Ultimately, where God commands, we must obey; where God does not command, we have the freedom to choose.*
