Discussion Questions

- 1. Have someone in your group give a brief recap of Sunday's message, highlighting the primary Scripture points and the main idea of the message.
- 2. How did this message strengthen and/or correct your previous ideas about this passage of Scripture? Was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? Did you learn anything new about God or yourself this week?
- 3. Read Luke 24:13-24. What observations can you make of this passage? What words or phrases stand out to you?
- 4. Read Luke 24:25-53. What observations can you make? What words or phrases stand out to you?
- 5. Read 24:25-27, and 44-47 again. What are some examples of how we can see Jesus in the Old Testament? (examples from the sermon were Gen. 3:15, Isaiah 53, Daniel 3:25)
- 6. If everything in the Old Testament finds its fulfillment in Jesus, how does this change the way we approach the Old Testament?
- 7. What action step do you need to take in response to this week's message? How can your group hold you accountable to this step?

Read through the attached reading schedule this week. As you do, ask yourself, "How does this passage of Scripture point to Jesus?"
