### **Discussion Questions**

1. Have someone in your group give a brief recap of Sunday's message, highlighting the primary Scripture points and the main idea of the message.
2. How did this message strengthen and/or correct your previous ideas about actively walking out your faith with courage and trusting that God is God? Was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? Did you learn anything new about God or yourself this week?
3. Who is someone in your life that is not widely known, but actively lives out his/her faith with courage and trusts that God is God? What about this person stands out to you?
4. What cultural or personal narratives try to pull away from the truth that you are accepted because God accepts you through Christ who is enough? What promises of God can you stand on in opposition to those narratives?
5. What cultural or personal narratives try to pull away from the truth that your security is found in the sovereign God of the universe who cares for you? What promises of God can you stand on in opposition to those narratives?
6. How are you actively serving God with a courageous faith or where is God calling you to serve?
7. What action step do you need to take in response to this week's message? How can your group hold you accountable to this step?

### **Action Step**

1. Thank the person you know who is not widely known, but lives a life of courageous faith and trusts that God is God.
2. Remind yourself of the promises of God as you courageously face the giant(s) in your life.
3. Actively serve God in your everyday life so that you have one story of faithfulness to share each day.
