Discussion Questions

1. Where in your life do you find it hardest to love faithfully or consistently?
2. In what ways might you be tempted to serve Jesus without letting Him first serve you? What would it look like this week to let Jesus wash your feet- to receive his mercy, grace, or even correction?
3. What does Sunday's passage reveal about how the Kingdom of God defines greatness?
4. Who is someone in your life who needs truth spoken with greatness and love, how can you approach that person while ensuring that when you speak truth it flows from love rather than pride?
5. How can we make sure our service meets practical needs while also pointing people to the hope of the Gospel?
6. Do you primarily think of serving as something you do, or as who you are? What is one specific step you can take this week to live more fully into your identity as a servant of Jesus?

Action Step

1. Confess any sin, pride, or weariness that may be hindering you from Christ like service.
2. Offer encouragement, forgiveness, or simply presence.
Jesus washed Judas' feet knowing betrayal was coming and that's the kind of humility we're growing toward.
3. Pray about a practical need that you may be able to contribute to.
