Discussion Questions

1. Have someone in your group give a brief recap of Sunday's message, highlighting the primary Scripture points and the main idea of the message.
2. How did this message strengthen and/or correct your previous ideas about Jesus as our King? Was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you? Did you learn anything new about God or yourself this week?
3. Read John 18:28-19:16. What stands out to you? Share your observations with the group.
4. Do you find yourself getting distracted from the truth, distorting the truth, or being cynical about what is true? If so, what are the things that can pull you away from the truth?
5. How can you pursue being a person who abides in the truth of Christ?
6. Jesus is our King with all authority. How does this encourage you in our world that is full of chaos and uncertainty?
7. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17. How does the return of Christ and the thought of his coming kingdom provide hope to us today?
8. What action step do you need to take in response to this week's message? How can your group hold you accountable to this step?

Action Step

1. Invite someone to join you for Good Friday or Easter Sunday.
2. Read Psalm 25. After you are finished reading, allow this psalm to give words to your prayers. Take time to ask the Lord to lead you in his truth and way.
